




It's beginning to feel a lot like Christmas! Thanks to Carly Murray for hosting a festive internal comms event last night in which Santa himself made a surprise appearance.

Great start to December. #barntoboardroom 🎄 📆








"Yes to listening and learning from employees ded"








# POLL RESULTS
